Do you remember the old gospel song Deep and Wide? No? Well, don't worry about it because that is not what I want to talk about anyway! I'm talking about a book by Andy Stanley, pastor at North Point Church in Georgia. Stanley's latest book, Deep and Wide, is a must read if you want to ponder the church in today's world. He asks two questions we all should be asking: what is the church and who is it for?

When Jesus first used the word we call *church*, it was His prediction of something which did not yet exist (Matthew 16:18). The word *ekklesia* is not a religious term; it is the common term which means "to gather for a purpose." It was to be a purposeful gathering. Stanley contends we moved church from an assembly to an assembly hall.

When was the last time we as local church leaders met and asked these hard questions?

- Are we moving or simply meeting?
- Are we making a measurable difference in our local communities or simply conducting services?
- Are we organized around a mission or are we organized around an antiquated ministry model?
- Are we allocating resources as if Jesus is the hope of the world, or

are the squeaky wheels of church culture driving our budgeting decisions?

Stanley also interacts with one of my

favourite descriptions of Jesus in John 1:14 when it tells us Jesus was "full of grace and truth." The New Testament Church was comfortable living with the ambiguity and tension of grace and truth (Acts 15).

Who is the church for? Is the church for church people only? Have we thought of those whom we pray will come who are not "church" people? I well remember coming to Jesus Christ in high school and entering the foreign world of the church. I knew I did not really belong because I was not like them. But, fortunately for me, I walked into a strong "grace and truth" church that enfolded me, loved me as I was, and shared Jesus with me. Plenty of grace and the true truth.

Bottom line: don't be a church designed by Christians for a "Christians only" culture. Think on it and do some good reading on it.
