MINISTRY DESCRIPTION:

South Calgary Chinese Evangelical Free Church (SCCEFC) is a thriving, family-oriented, missions-focused church in Calgary, Alberta. Since 1988, SCCEFC has grown and now serves three congregations (Cantonese, English, and Mandarin) with a total weekly attendance of more than 900. Our Cantonese Congregation consists of seniors, baby boomers, families with young children as well as early career adults and students. Our Worship attendance is approximately 600 weekly.

We are currently looking for either an Associate Pastor (with some pastoral experience) or Assistant pastor (with little or no experience) who will provide leadership and pastoral care within the Cantonese Congregation.

PERSONAL QUALIFICATIONS:

- Master's degree from an evangelical seminary or higher theological training (preferred but not required)

- Fluent in Cantonese and good English communication skills is required
- Minimum of two years pastoral experience (Associate Pastor)
- Experience working within a cross-cultural context. Care more about people than about running successful programs, and a disciple making pastor who demonstrate a true disciple

MINISTRY DUTIES:

- Provide pastoral leadership and ministry to the Couples Zone.
- Offer pastoral care and discipleship training to the leaders serving within the Couples Zone.
- Participate in general pastoral duties, including preaching, teaching Sunday School, conducting visitations, and leading prayer meetings.
- Serve under the leadership of the Lead Pastor and work collaboratively with the pastoral team and Deacons to implement the church's vision, mission, values, and ministry plans.
